2. Health Guarantee at Time of Sale

Seller guarantees the puppy is in good health at the time of sale and has received age-appropriate vaccinations and deworming. The puppy has been examined by a licensed veterinarian prior to leaving Seller's care.

Buyer must have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours of possession. Failure to complete this exam voids all health guarantees.

If a veterinarian determines the puppy has a serious life-threatening health condition making it unfit for purchase, Buyer may return the puppy for a full refund of the purchase price within the 72-hour time frame.

Minor conditions such as parasites, ear infections, stress diarrhea, or fleas are not grounds for return. Seller is not responsible for veterinary expenses or transportation costs.

3. Buyer Responsibilities

Buyer agrees to provide proper care for the puppy, including but not limited to routine veterinary care, vaccinations, parasite prevention, appropriate nutrition, safe housing, and adequate training and socialization. Buyer further agrees to maintain the puppy in a safe and healthy environment at all times.

Failure to provide proper care, as determined by a licensed veterinarian, shall void all health guarantees outlined in this agreement.

4. Genetic Health Guarantee

Seller warrants that, to the best of their knowledge, the puppy is in good health at the time of sale and free from life-altering congenital defects. This includes, but is not limited to, hereditary cardiac conditions (including clinically significant heart murmurs), orthopedic defects (including hip dysplasia, elbow dysplasia, and luxating patellas), and other genetic abnormalities that significantly impact the puppy's quality of life. This guarantee is valid for one (1) year from the date of purchase.

Veterinary Examination Requirement

Buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within seventy-two (72) hours of receipt. This examination must include evaluation of overall health, including cardiac and orthopedic conditions. Failure to complete this examination within the required timeframe will render this Health Guarantee null and void.

Initial 72-Hour Guarantee (All Placements)

If a licensed veterinarian diagnoses a life-altering congenital defect within seventy-two (72) hours of receipt, Buyer may return the puppy to Seller for a full refund of the purchase price. **Buyer is responsible for travel expenses for the return of said puppy.**

Seller does not accept returns after the initial seventy-two (72) hour period.

Pet Homes (Limited Registration)

If a life-altering congenital defect is diagnosed after seventy-two (72) hours but within one (1) year of purchase, no cash refund will be issued.

Seller will assist Buyer in placing the puppy in an appropriate pet home and may, at Seller's discretion, offer credit toward a future puppy.

Breeding Homes (Full Registration)

If a licensed veterinarian diagnoses a life-altering congenital defect within one (1) year of purchase, Seller agrees to refund the difference between the breeding price and the established pet price of \$2,500.

Buyer must provide written documentation from a licensed veterinarian confirming the diagnosis.

Puppies will not be accepted back after seventy-two (72) hours from the time they leave Seller's care. Seller will assist Buyer in placing the puppy in a suitable pet home.

General Terms

This Health Guarantee applies only to congenital and hereditary conditions and does not cover injuries, environmental factors, neglect, improper care, or conditions arising after the puppy leaves Seller's care that are not genetic in nature.

5. Conditions Not Covered

Not covered: allergies, accidents, injuries, ingestion of foreign objects, cancer, ear infections, urinary infections, behavioral issues, bite alignment issues, umbilical hernias, or illness caused by improper care or environment.

All puppies undergo a thorough examination by a licensed Vet, and if any such ailments are noted, buyers will be notified immediately.

Size, color, coat type, and temperament cannot be guaranteed.

6. Breeding Restrictions

Unless full breeding rights are purchased, the puppy is sold strictly as a companion pet and must be spayed or neutered by 12 months of age with proof provided.

If the puppy is bred without written authorization from Dreier's Fire Poodles, Buyer agrees to pay \$10,000 in damages plus legal costs.

7. Undescended Testicle Clause

In the event a male puppy sold with breeding rights is found to have one or both testicles not descended by six (6) months of age, Buyer may be eligible for a refund of the difference between the breeding price and defined pet price, upon submission of written documentation from a licensed veterinarian and verification of neuter completed.

The pet price is defined as \$2,500 for Miniature Poodles and \$3,000 for Toy Poodles. This condition does not warrant the return of the puppy. All determinations must be made within the specified timeframe and supported by veterinary documentation.

8. Return to Breeder Agreement

The puppy may never be surrendered to a shelter, rescue, or pet store. If Buyer cannot keep the dog, Dreier's Luxury Poodles must be contacted first so Seller can assist in rehoming. No refunds will be issued for voluntary returns.

9. Deposits and Payment

Purchase Price: \$_____

A non-refundable \$500 deposit is required to reserve a puppy and secure placement on the selection list. Deposits are only refundable if Seller cannot provide the puppy.

Remaining balance must be paid before the puppy leaves Seller's care. Accepted payments include Cash, Venmo, Zelle, or cleared personal check.

10. Puppy Selection & Pickup

Puppy selection occurs between 3–5 weeks of age in deposit order. Seller reserves the right to retain breeding-quality puppies for the program before pet selections.

Puppies go home at approximately 8 weeks of age.

11. Boarding Policy

If the puppy is not picked up on the agreed date (by 9 weeks of age), boarding will be charged \$20 per day. Buyers will pay all occurred boarding fees at pick up.

12. Limitation of Liability

Upon transfer of ownership, Buyer assumes full responsibility for the puppy including veterinary care, feeding, training, and all associated expenses. Seller is not liable for incidental or consequential damages.

13. Governing Law

This agreement is governed by the laws of the State of California.
